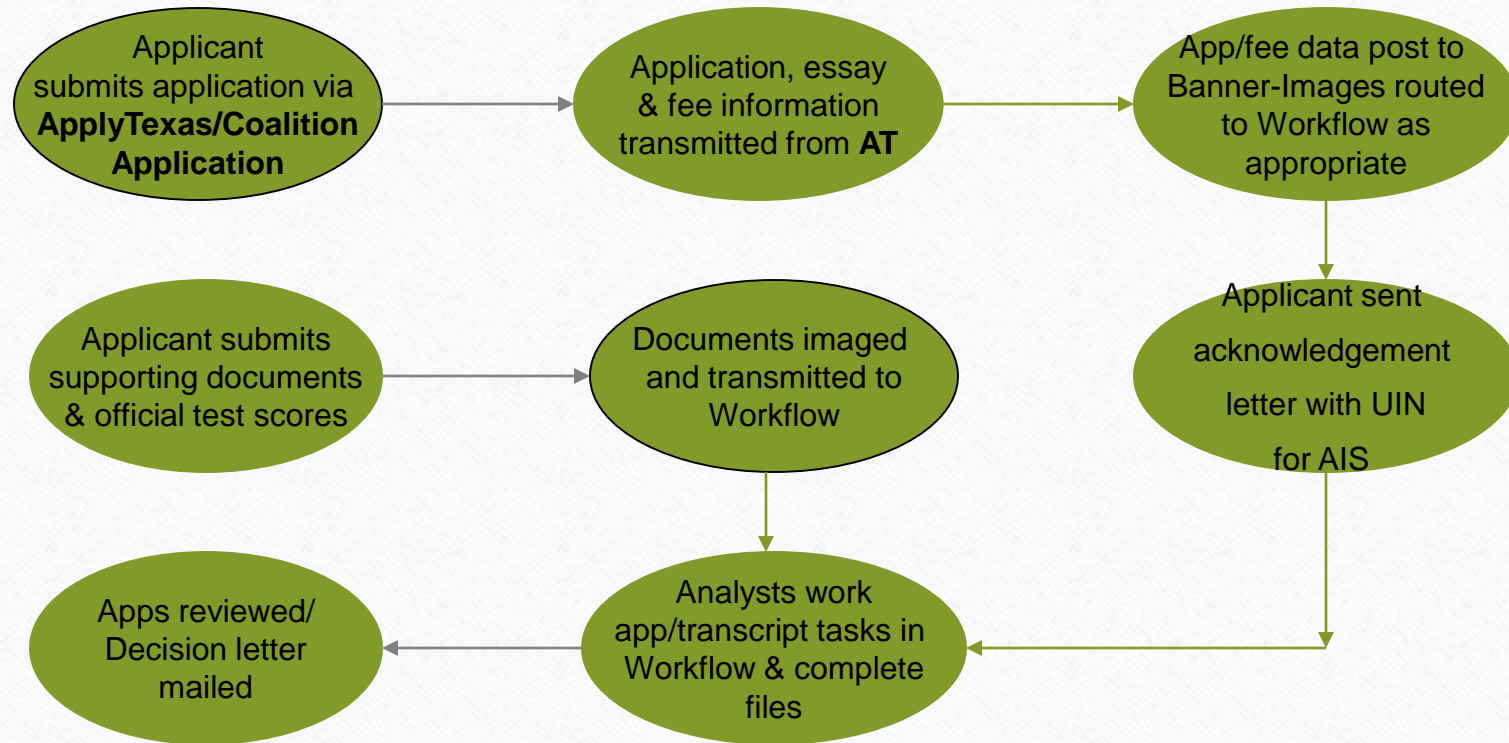

Official Test Scores

TOEFL Minimums

Paper-based exam: 550

Internet-based exam: 80

Students will not be reviewed for admission if they do not meet minimums.

Official Test Scores

TOEFL Exemptions

- Official SAT EBRW score of 560 or higher (old CR score 500)
- Official ACT English score of 21 or higher
- Four-year attendance and graduation from high school accredited by the U.S.
- Official IELTS score of 6.0 overall band
- PTE Academic score of 53
- English is official language of applicant's home country

Undergraduate Review System

URS

- Transfer students will be available for review for Spring 2018 at this time.
- It is our plan to make the system available for all undergraduate application types (NDS, Readmit, PB) for the summer/fall cycle.
- URS is a module within the Applicant Information System (AIS) and can be accessed by logging in to **applicant.tamu.edu**.
- Each college has a College Admin who will assign access and permissions.

Academic Fresh Start (AFS)

- Texas residents and have had academic coursework ten years prior to their application can be considered for **AFS**.
- Students applying for admission or readmission to and plan to use (**AFS**) must submit the completed form to Admissions by the application deadline.
- All academic coursework that has been forfeited prior to ten years cannot be considered as prerequisites for courses currently required in the degree plan.
- A student will not be allowed to revoke the election of **AFS** once it has been acted upon by any institution.

Readmit Admission Codes

- **AR** – Student is admitted by college with no conditions
- **AP** – Student is admitted by college with probationary terms upon enrollment
- **AG** – Student is admitted by college with conditions, GPR required on current semester coursework (The admitting college is responsible for setting the terms and blocking the student from registration until final transcript has been received).
- **DR** – Student is being denied by department
